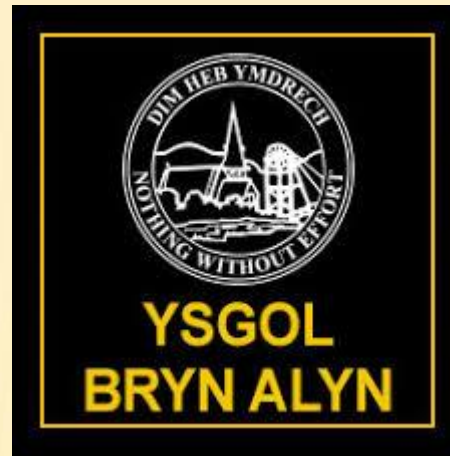

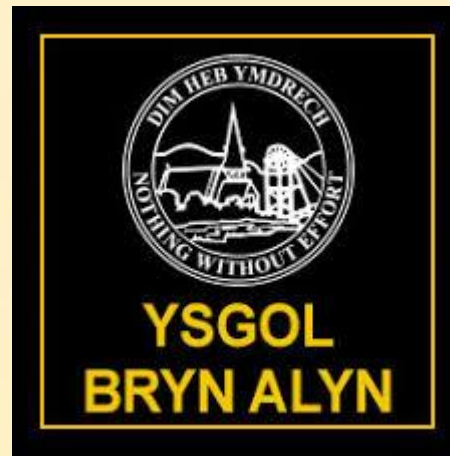

LIQUIDS GUIDANCE

easyJet

Passengers may carry small quantities of liquids, but only within separate containers each of which with a capacity not greater than 100ml.

These containers must be brought to the airport contained in a single, transparent, re-sealable plastic bag (about the size of a small freezer bag), which itself must not exceed 1 litre in capacity (approximately 20cm x 20cm). The contents of the plastic bag must fit comfortably and the bag sealed. Each passenger may carry only one such bag of liquids which must fit comfortably within the single permitted item of hand baggage.

The bag must be presented separately for examination at the airport security point.

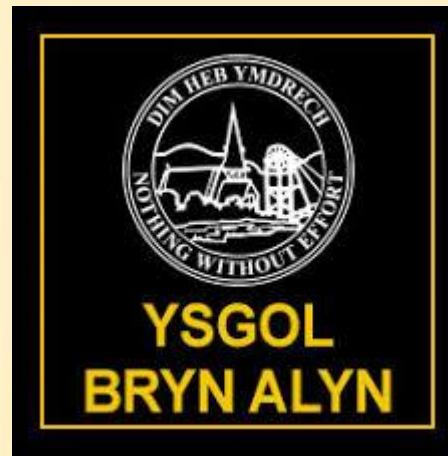
Please note: - Any containers larger than 100ml (excluding essential medicines, see website for further details) will NOT be allowed through the security search point. - Most liquids of any amount may still be carried in hold baggage.

Remember that 'Liquids' includes: *All drinks, including water, soup, syrups. *Creams, lotions, oils, perfumes, mascara etc. *Sprays and pressurized containers including shaving foam and spray deodorants. *Pastes, including toothpaste* Gels, including hair and shower gel *Any other solutions and items of similar consistency

Please note that liquids can usually be purchased beyond airport security search points, in the departures area, as these liquids are subject to a separate screening process.

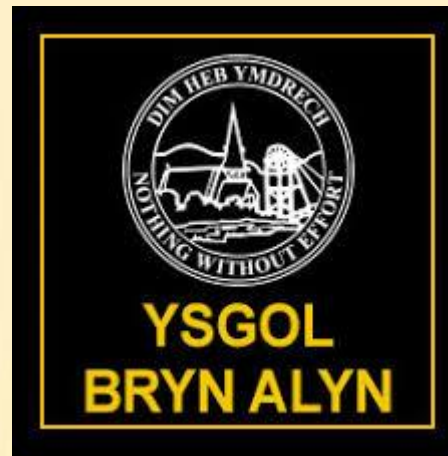

GROUP B: Mr Scragg

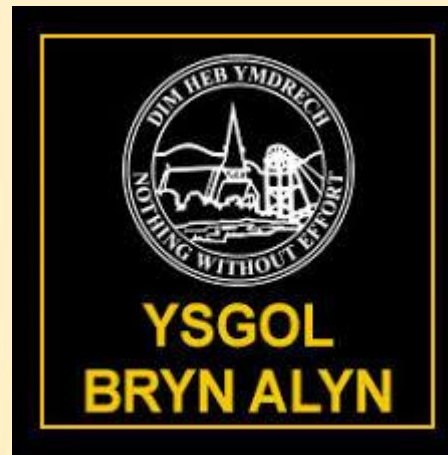
GROUP C: Mr Ledger

Government guidelines

RUN



Run to a place of safety. This is a far better option than to surrender or negotiate. If there's nowhere to go, then...

HIDE

TELL



Tell the police by calling 999.



Conduct and Behaviour during the trip

- No swearing (hotel, airport plane, coach etc).
- Inappropriate comments (mentioning a bomb at the airport for example).
- No contact of parents/guardians if a pupil is injured (Mr A Jones will contact parents first to avoid any panic).
- No purchase of alcohol or cigarettes.
- Keep hotel room clean and tidy. Report any damage.
- No one is to leave hotel / airport / training ground on their own or without permission.
- *Under no circumstance are pupil to act dangerously on the hotel balconies.*
- Be present at the meeting points at the designated times.
