Ysgol Bryn Alyn School Uniform Policy 2026 - 2027

Uniform is an important part of a school's identity. It reinforces who we are as a community and helps allow students to feel pride in their school. It also ensures students are not put under any pressure because of the type of clothes they wear, and all are treated equally. It also helps prepare students for life after school where many will have to dress smartly for work or wear specific work/company uniform.

Please take note of the uniform policy outlined in this leaflet. We feel that consistency is important for all students and would like to avoid unnecessary confrontations at the start of term with students beginning YBA or returning to us in September not dressed in accordance with school uniform policy.

Our uniform supplier is Ram Leisure, based in Wrexham. The company work from the Whitegate Industrial estate and have a comprehensive website through which you will be able to order your YBA uniform.

A reminder that **all pupils** (Year 7 – 11) will be expected to be wearing the school blazer, a white shirt, school clip on tie, black trousers (please see overleaf for guidelines) or the **standard school skirt** (not rolled up – the skirt is a standard length) *Please note, no other skirt will be accepted – more details overleaf.* A black v-neck jumper is optional in the Winter and Spring terms, however, please note that this jumper needs to be worn outside the skirt or trouser. **Please also note that during the Summer Term, the black v-neck jumper is NOT part of our summer uniform and therefore should not be worn. However, tailored black shorts are permitted to be worn during the summer term.**

Pupils will be expected to wear a pair of plain black, polishable shoes. Please also be aware that **trainer socks are NOT permitted. Socks must cover the ankle and at least meet the base of the trousers.**

Parents can apply for the Pupil Development Grant (available for all 'Free School Meal' pupils) to help with buying uniform and equipment. Our 'new' Year 7 pupils receive extra support with the costs associated with joining secondary school. Our pupils look extremely smart in their uniform and by abiding to the clear uniform policy, crucially, valuable staff time will not be spent dealing with issues relating to problems with school uniform. As a community we are all proud of our young people and are passionate about giving them the best opportunities.

We do have a Uniform Hub at YBA to support with any day-to-day uniform issues. If a pupil is wearing incorrect uniform (including shoes), we will issue the required uniform item for that day and will expect this to be returned at the end of the school day. If the item of uniform borrowed is not returned within three days, then parents will be charged via ParentPay for the item. Please see attached uniform flowchart for your information.

Thank you for your continued support and please do not hesitate to contact the school if you would like clarification on any uniform item. We look forward to your support in ensuring all students are treated equally and trust the information enclosed in this policy makes things much clearer for everyone.

All pupils are required to wear a grey blazer with a gold trim, embroidered with the YBA logo. Both boys and girls blazers are available and any blazer with the old logo will still be in regulation.



A YBA school tie is required. It is a black (clip on) tie with a gold stripe (Years 7 – 10) The Year 11 tie is a gold with a black stripe.



A school standard tartan skirt is available for those who wish to wear a skirt. *Please be aware that no other skirt will be accepted.*

All items of YBA uniform (including those above) can be purchased from Ram Leisure based in Wrexham.

The company also stock our 'recommended trouser' for both boys and girls and black v-necked jumpers (for use in the winter and spring term only).

Plain white shirts, long or short sleeved are available from all major supermarkets and retailers such as Matalan and Marks & Spencer



A plain black v neck jumper may be worn under the blazer during the winter and spring terms only. Jumpers are available from our supplier, Ram Leisure or from major supermarkets and other retailers such as Matalan and Marks & Spencer

Trouser Guidance

Trousers should be black, **straight legged (NOT skinny fit)**, loose around the whole leg and ankle, tailored, cotton/polyester/viscose, and full length (resting on the shoe). The following items are **NOT acceptable**

- leggings/jeggings,
- jogging/tracksuit bottoms
- Any trouser made from canvas, jersey, lycra or denim fabrics.
- Please do not purchase trousers from the New Look range as these DO NOT conform to our uniform standard.



To avoid any confusion, trousers purchased from our school uniform supplier, Ram Leisure, is what we recommend. Please see their website for further details.

For the summer term only - Shorts can be worn by all students; **they should be black tailored shorts and be knee length**. Skinny-fit, cargo or jean-style shorts are NOT permitted.

Further presentation guidance

Jewellery	<p>The only jewellery permitted in school is:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stud earrings (maximum of two pairs). Hoop earrings and spacers are not allowed. • One plain, flat ring. • A wristwatch. <p>All jewellery must be removed for PE lessons. Jewellery must not be covered with plasters.</p> <p><u>Nose Piercings</u> Nose studs or rings are not permitted in school.</p> <p>While there is no single legal minimum age for nose piercings in the UK, most reputable providers will not carry out this procedure on those under 16 without parental consent. In Wales, the law prohibits “intimate” piercings (such as tongue, nipple or genital piercings) for anyone under 18.</p> <p><u>Additional Restrictions</u></p>

	Signet rings, multiple earrings beyond the permitted number, and all other body piercings are not allowed in school
Hair	Hair should be of one natural colour . Extremes of fashion are not acceptable within school. Long hair should be tied back for PE, Technology, and other practical activities.
Nails	No nail extensions are permitted (on the grounds of health and safety), nails should be natural in colour.
Make Up	Make up is not permitted in KS3. Pupils in KS4 may have subtle natural make up (no extremes of eye and lip colour) and no eyelash extensions

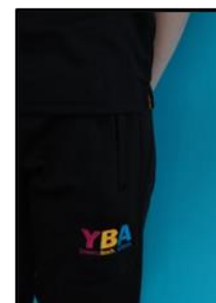
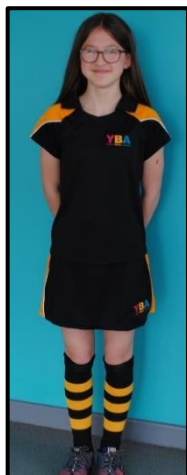

PERMITTED FOOTWEAR:

	<p>ARTIFICIAL GROUND (AG) <small>RECOMMENDED</small></p> <p>Specifically designed for extra abrasion, these boots usually feature more numerous and densely concentrated studs that vary in height and may be hollowed out.</p>		<p>FIRM GROUND (FG) <small>RECOMMENDED</small></p> <p>Sole plates feature moulded studs which are evenly dispersed across the foot to offer enhanced traction and comfort.</p>
	<p>HARD GROUND (HG) <small>RECOMMENDED</small></p> <p>Sole plates utilise a harder Thermoplastic polyurethanes compound for enhanced durability and typically feature multiple slightly shorter, evenly dispersed studs for optimal pressure distribution.</p>		<p>TURF TRAINER (TF) <small>RECOMMENDED</small></p> <p>Otherwise known as Astro's, they feature a solid rubber outsole with numerous, small multidirectional lugs spread across the sole, which offer limited grip in wet conditions.</p>

Please be aware that the following footwear is not allowed...

FORBIDDEN FOOTWEAR:

	<p>SOFT GROUND (SG) <small>TEAR THE SURFACE</small></p> <p>Sole features removable, replaceable screw-in studs and typically come in a six-stud configuration, with four at the forefoot and two at the heel.</p>
	<p>SOFT GROUND PRO (SGP) <small>TEAR THE SURFACE</small></p> <p>Also known as Hybrid or Mixed Stud, the sole plate comprises of a combination of conical screw-in studs and moulded studs, which are most commonly bladed.</p>
	<p>BLADES <small>CAN CAUSE INJURY</small></p> <p>Sole plates feature multiple straight slightly shorter, evenly dispersed studs that can restrict movement and turning which could cause injury.</p>
	<p>FLAT SOLE (INDOOR) <small>NO GRIP & FLATTENS SURFACE</small></p> <p>Sole made up of non-marking materials such as moulded gum rubber and feature pivot points, flex grooves and herringbone patterns.</p>

- Swimwear (plain, dark one piece)

In addition to the above items, we **strongly recommend** that pupils wear appropriate protective clothing/items when engaging in contact sports during PE and games of a competitive nature, including shin-pads for football**. *(Year 7 parents – if you have to purchase football boots for your child, please wait until they start in September when they will be given more information from the Health and Wellbeing Faculty about WHEN they are doing their football module – they may not need them immediately)*

If your child is not participating in PE for a medical reason and you have provided the expected note, please ensure that they bring their full PE kit as they still can change, taking on a coaching or officiating role in the lesson to enable them to continue their learning.

Additional Information

Pupils are required to carry a bag which is suitable to carry A4 sized books/folders
 Each pupil needs their own pack of equipment that is strictly for him or her, this must not be shared. We request that all equipment is placed in a pencil case which is clearly labelled.

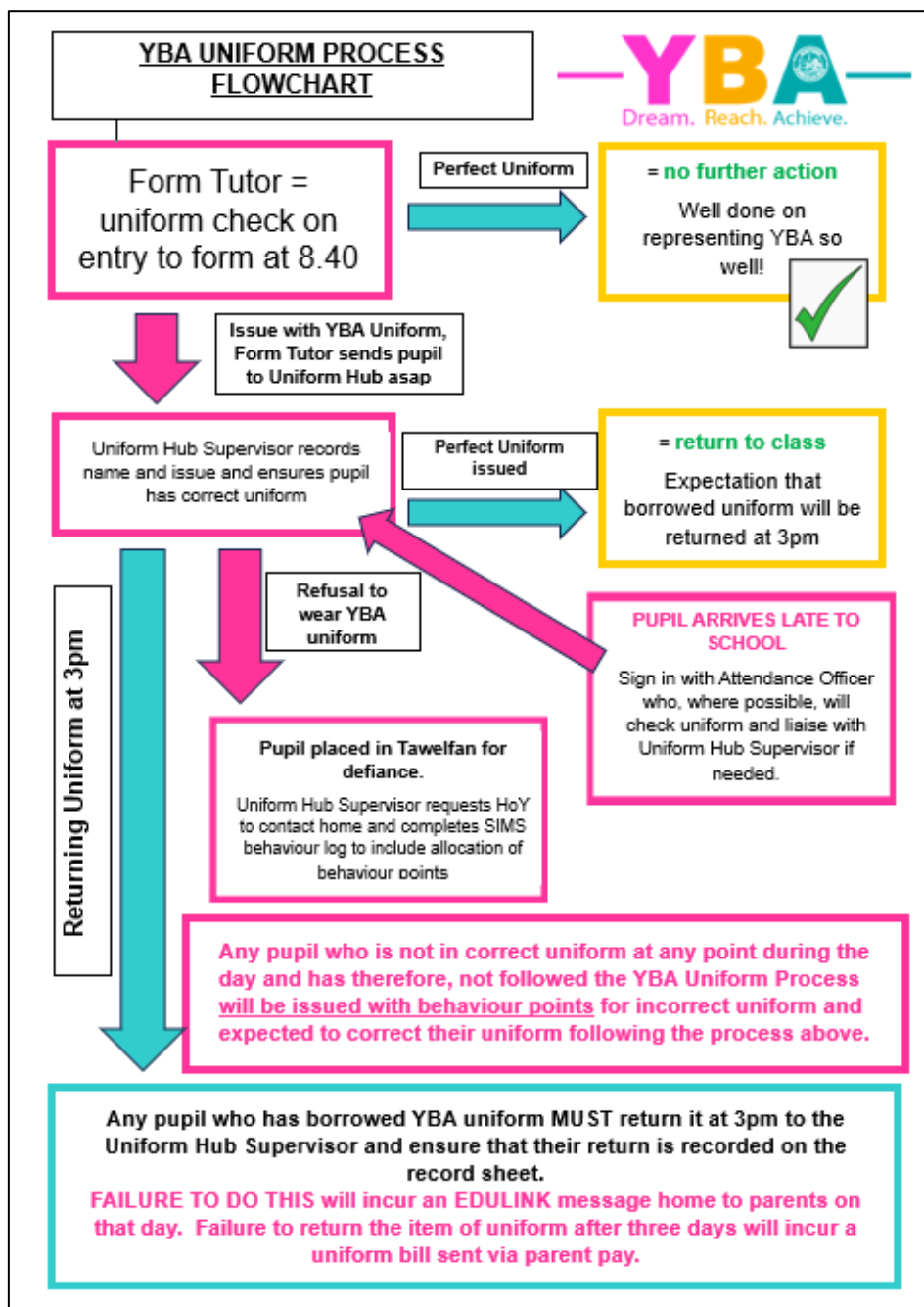
